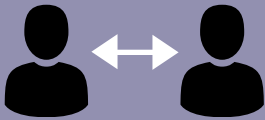


CONDUCTING IN-PERSON VISITS DURING COVID-19

By working together and following safety protocols, we can ensure in-person visits with family are safe for everyone.

SAFETY MEASURES



Physical Distancing

Although the province is beginning to allow visitation with family members, it is still important to adhere to a physical distance of 6 feet (2 metres) to protect both you and your loved ones.



Personal Protective Equipment

Wearing a face covering such as a mask helps prevent the spread of germs. Make sure you're wearing yours properly, fully covering both your nose and mouth during the entirety of the visit.



Screening Measures

Be prepared to answer a questionnaire about your health. You may also have your temperature taken and be observed for any physical symptoms before conducting your visit.
