Bylaw 4.2.e: The Chair of the **Nominating Committee shall** inquire among Members of the Association, at least 30 days prior to an AGM or Special Meeting as to the persons whom the members would propose be nominated for the offices of President-Elect and Board members.

April 12, 2021	Candidates announced electronically via e-TRO and the TRO website with proposed motion re: 5 Directors-at-Large
May 12, 2021	Election at AGM

# 2021 General Election



- •Bylaw 3.6: Ten (10) percent of Members, two of whom must be Officers, present at the commencement of an AGM or Special Meeting constitutes a quorum.
- •Bylaw 3.5.a: Only Professional Members in good standing with the Association can vote at an AGM.

# 2021 General Election



- •Bylaw 2.1.c: Professional Members shall each have the right to one vote at all meetings of the members of the Corporation.
- •Bylaw 2.3.b: An Associate Member is eligible to attend Association functions and events, but not to hold office or vote.
- •Bylaw 2.4.b: A Student Member may attend Association functions and/or meetings, but does not have voting privileges.




**Bylaw 4.2.a**: Elections of Board members shall be by secret ballot and shall be held in conjunction with the AGM.

#### **Procedures for General Election**

# Report from the bylaws Committee - Sue Verrilli, R/TRO

- Committee members:
  - Judy Beitz, R/TRO, former board member
  - Monica Almas, R/TRO, board member
  - Rozalyn Werner-Arcé, Executive Director
  - Sue Verrilli, R/TRO, Past-President
- Began meeting August 2018
- Reviewed the existing bylaws, identified gaps and opportunities
- Attempted to hold a meeting in Dec 2020 but we did not have quorum



### Why Change the bylaws?

- 1. Modernize the bylaws to allow for greater flexibility and succession planning
- 2. Ensure compliance with current legislation
- 3. Ensure compliance with incoming provincial legislation, the Ontario Not-for-

**Profit Corporations Act (ONCA)**, which is expected to take effect in 2021.



### Highlights of Major Changes

- **Two membership classes** Professional and Associate, to allow for greater flexibility as the association grows and evolves. Categories, such as Registered Professional, Students, etc. will be created within the two classes and do not need to be identified in the bylaws.
- **Reduce quorum from 15% to 10%** In the past, we have had AGMs where we have not been able to meet quorum. Therefore, TRO has not met our legal requirements, nor have members been able to exercise their right to vote.
- **Appointment of the Officers** Officers are the President, President-elect, Past-President and Secretary. The recommended change allows the Board to plan for succession and, we hope, will encourage members to consider becoming a future president.
- Changing committee structure allows for greater flexibility


